These updates included conceptual designs and layout of the new facility.

Sharon Covey, Dubuque Community YMCA/YWCA’s President/CEO says it’s exciting to see what the new Y could look like. “We are pleased to see conceptual designs of what the new facility could look like. We are still in the early stages of design but excited about the direction we are heading.” Covey continued by emphasizing that, “The Y is more than a place to work out — we are a place of community. Of course, members will have access to new machines, our basketball court and swimming pool, but there will be so much more. With a new facility and more space we will continue to align our programming by meeting the needs of the community. Programming will include several Y-USA evidenced-based programs including: Diabetes Prevention Program, Blood Pressure Self-Monitoring Program, Enhanced Fitness (arthritis management), and the LiveStrong Program for cancer survivors. We will continue to offer and grow our Reach & Rise® 1-1 Mentoring and Group Mentoring programs, Restorative Strategies program, Victim Services Shelter, and Camp.”
